### Conducting Expression series

- Last date for submission – 20<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- For entries, i.e. Essays/Paragraphs/paintings/Poems, participants sheet given as **annexure 1**.
- School will shortlist the students. One entry per category and submit the same to CBSE.
- Each participant will get an online certificate of participation at his/her registered email ID after the successful submission of entry.
- 10 best entries of each category will be selected at the regional level by all CBSE regions for onward submission to CBSE New Delhi.
- Three best entries will be selected at the national level. All of these best entries shall be compiled in the form of a booklet for display on CBSE website.
- The decision /result given by the evaluation committee shall be final and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
